Club Rules

- Posted practice and 3D ranges are for Heart of Maryland Bowhunters members only.
- 2. Non-members, please use the public range at your own risk.
- 3. The Heart of Maryland Bowhunters Club, at it's discretion, may take any and all necessary action to assure the safe operation and use of it's facilities and reserves the right and has final decision on what may be permitted on the range. HMB reserves the right to revoke usage rights to any individual who does not comply with the Archery Range Rules.
- 4. All persons accessing member only areas of the grounds must have on file a completed liability waiver form. This includes all guests of members, even if a non-shooting spectator. Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a legal guardian indicated on the HMB liability waiver.
- 5. No hunting is permitted at any time on the HMB range, HMB maintained areas, parking lot area, and access paths.
- 6. Permitted equipment includes the following: Longbow, recurve or compound bows. Absolutely no crossbows, or firearms are permitted. Field points only, no Broadheads.
- 7. Follow all signage instructions on the trails. Do not cross into chained off paths or areas.
- 8. Lock the gate and spin the numbers if you are the last to leave the premises.
